DIRECTED STUDY BLOCK (DSB) ATTENDANCE AND ACCOUNTABILITY

Attend DSB When Assigned

Directed Study Block is mandatory for any student assigned to attend who may be at risk of being unsuccessful in their learning.

1st Missed DSB

If you are assigned to DSB and do not attend, the classroom teacher will:

- 1
 - Reassign to the next available DSB session.
 - Contact home to inform your parent/guardian of the missed session and the importance of attending.

2nd Missed DSB

If you miss the reassigned DSB session:

- 2
 - You may be assigned to Reflection Hall or the classroom teachers' choice of intervention and be reassigned a third time to a future DSB session.
 - Home will be contacted again with the appropriate VP copied, to reinforce the importance of attendance and to offer support if needed.

3rd Or Ongoing Missed DSB

If you continue to miss DSB after three attempts by your teacher:

- 3
 - At this point, responsibility for attending DSB lies with you.
 - You will face the natural academic consequences of not participating in the support provided (e.g., incomplete assignments, missed learning opportunities, or impact on course standing such as failure and repeating the course).
