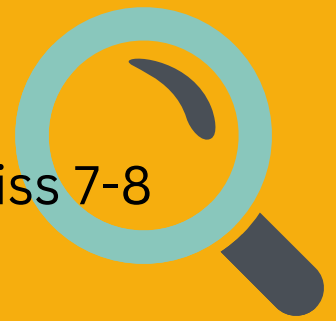


RHS ATTENDANCE EXPECTATIONS

DID YOU KNOW?

Did you know that on average, RHS students miss 7-8 days of classes per semester?



And did you know that if you are late for class, you are marked tardy, but if you are more than 20 minutes late, or miss more than 20 minutes during class then you are marked absent? Missing 20 minutes or more means you have missed crucial instructional time.

WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT?

Attending school regularly will improve your chance of being academically successful and reflects your engagement with your learning.

A habit of good attendance helps you learn the future skills, persistence, and grit required for success in post-secondary environments as well as the workforce.

RHS EXPECTATIONS FOR ABSENCES

10 days missed- Conversation with the attendance liaison about why you have been absent, what is required to catch up, and contact home.

15 days missed- Conversation with your VP, Guidance and Resource team about how we can help and put a plan in action and contact home. Meeting with your parents/guardians and placed on an attendance contract/academic plan.

25 days missed- If the attendance contract/academic plan was not successful, you will be placed on a complementary assessment status meaning you are welcome in class, but teachers are not required to reteach missed materials. At the teacher's discretion, you may still be able to do a final assessment for a chance to pass with a 60%.
